HERE AT POMELO GROVE.

WE'RE AN OFF-THE-GRID CAMPGROUND, CONSCIOUS OF POWER & WATER USAGE.

HERE ARE THE MOST IMPORTANT POINTS:

WATER + SHOWERS

Please be aware of water usage during your stay by turning off faucets when not actively using water and by limiting your shower time. It is best to limit showers to 6 minutes due to the size of our water heaters. Your water tank holds 40 gallons and we top it off daily! Turn on the water heater in the kitchen cabinet by turning the dial to hot. Allow 20 minutes for the water to heat for your shower and reheat for the next one. Turn the dial back down after use to ensure our power runs smoothly for other appliances.

COMPOSTING TOILET

You will be using a self-contained composting toilet during your stay. We have provided an instructional card on the wall beside your toilet to guide operation of the step, crank, composting drum and dry compost mix. Solids and liquids can go into the chamber.

NO OPEN FLAMES

Please do not use candles or other open flames inside or near the campers, and ensure charcoal grills are at least 10 feet away from your camper when in use.

POWER/GENERATOR

POWERING OUR GROVE IS NO SMALL TASK.

Pomelo Grove is an off-the-grid campground. We strive for the most sustainable power options while maintaining the integrity of the land we are inhabiting. Unplugging items that aren't in use, or turning off the A/C when not inside (or when breezy, open windows suffice) are ways to help conserve the power of the small generators that power our campers.

OUR GENERATORS

Your space is powered by generator! If any of your appliances power off, the generator is overloaded. Contact your host, Erin, and turn things off until the generator is able to power back up.

ONE APPLIANCE AT A TIME

Between the A/C, water heater, and stove, **please use only one of these appliances at a time, turning the other 2 off— o**therwise our generator becomes overloaded and shuts off. This one modification allows us to use a smaller generator, keeping our footprint minimal.

INDUCTION STOVETOP

This system heats food extremely quickly, is cool to the touch, and doesn't transfer heat to the air (a major plus for such a small space!) Your kitchen is fully stocked with induction-ready cookware that will provide the best possible cooking experience. Please do not use the cooktop while other appliances are turned on.

COMPOSTING TOILET

A SIMPLE, NOT SMELLY, OFF-GRID SOLUTION

The self-contained composting toilet in the bathroom requires no water and very simple maintenance. If you've never used a composting toilet this may seem daunting or scary, but it's simple!

Composting toilets work by breaking down waste in a chamber beneath the toilet. These toilets require little power and no water., chemical treatment, or icky black tank waste storage. Deciding on a composting toilet was an easy choice for our campers and the consciousness we strive to bring with our off-grid set up. When ready to use, open the toilet seat and make sure the composting drum opening is positioned right under the toilet seat. If it is not, turn the crank located on the front of the toilet. Grab the stool next to the toilet, and hook it onto the front of the toilet to help you feel comfortable while you take a seat. Both liquids and solids go into the chamber. For every solid contribution, add 1 scoop of dry compost mix stashed under the sink (which is just of peat moss and hemp stalk!) and turn the crank clockwise until the drum opening is back up. Please dispose of feminine hygiene products in the trash can, but if you use a cup, you can dump the contents in the toilet along with 1/2 scoop of dry compost mix.

WATER

EVERY DROP TOTED IN FOR OUR GROVE

The water flowing through our campers is potable water that is toted in to our off- grid location.

There is also a water-purifying carafe in your refrigerator for your drinking water refreshment.

Our shower heads are low flow (1.5 gpm) and have a 6 gallon water heater, which allows approximately a 6 minute shower until the heated water runs out. It takes 20 minutes to reheat for the next shower. Because of the high power usage of the water heater and the stove, these two appliances cannot be running at the same time.

The Good Fill strives to be a zero waste business, so all of our dispensers are refillable. All of the Good Fill's products are synthetic free, hypoallergenic, cruelty free, vegan, 100% biodegradable, paraben free, soy free, gluten free, dye free, palm oil free. KITCHEN

COOKING, SNACKS, + COMPOSTING

FRENCH PRESS INSTRUCTIONS

Our coffee is a custom blend by local roastery Stay Golden Coffee Co. Remove the lid, add 1/2 cup of ground coffee to the pot, pour hot water (not quite boiling) into the pot, and gently stir. Carefully reinsert the plunger into the pot, stopping just above the water and ground coffee. Let stand for 3-4 minutes, plunge and enjoy!

COOKING FATS

Because your used (grey) water is collected in a tank below your camper, we want to protect the pipes and tank. Please dispose of cooking fats and excess oils in the trash can provided under the sink.

SNACKS

Please enjoy all the snacks provided to you! These containers are replaced with fresh, clean jars after each guest.

COMPOSTING

We try to eliminate waste by using washable and reusable products and by composting. Please add coffee grounds, tea bags, veggie scraps, and breads to the compost bin under the sink. All animal products (meats, fats, bones, dairy) should go in the trash.

CLEANING CAST IRON SKILLETS

You can use a small amount of soap. If needed, use the bristled brush to remove stubborn food. Dry promptly and thoroughly. If you notice a little black residue on your towel, it's just seasoning and is perfectly normal. Rub a very light layer of oil onto the surface, and wipe off excess.

YOUR ACCOMMODATION

MAKE YOURSELF AT HOME

CORDLESS BLINDS

Gently push down on the tabs located on our blinds to close them, and gently lift them up to return them to desired position. They don't need a lot of force.

CONVERTING TABLE TO A BED

Your tabletop can be reconfigured to provide extra sleeping space. The tabletop unscrews from the post, and the post unscrews from the floor. The tabletop then lowers to sit on the bench ledge—or simply remove it, if you want to use the bench as a couch.

LUGGAGE STORAGE

Please use the compartments under the bed to store your luggage during your stay.

GRILLS

Please move the grill at least 10 feet away from the camper before using. You will find charcoal, lighter fluid, lighters, and grill tools in the bin outside next to your grill.

ACTIVITIES

FOR YOUR ENTERTAINMENT DURING YOUR STAY

RECORD PLAYER

Plug the record player in using the adapter, and power on. Place the record on the turntable using the 45 adapter. Set the speed selector to 45 rpm, and push the lever up to raise the tone arm, placing it gently on the record. When done, return the tone arm to the arm rest, and power down.

CARDS. DICE. BOOKS. COLORING BOOKS. PUZZLE BOOKS +BOARD GAMES

Please enjoy these goodies, which can be found in the cubbies above the bed or in the bottom drawer to the right of the bed.

GUEST BOOK

We love to see our guests' faces and hear about what inspired your stay with us. Take a selfie with the camera provided, tape it in the guest book and write us a note! Other guests love to read these as well. If you wish, take one photo to remember your time here at the grove!

OUTDOOR ACTIVITIES

Bocce ball, badminton, cornhole, and other outdoor games are located in the grey box on the edge of the Pomelo field.

FIRE PIT

The nightly fire will be built in the center pit at sundown. Bring the provided s'mores kit and roasting sticks and enjoy!

BLOOMSBURY

Bloomsbury Farm has an open door policy. Feel free to hike around the property. Follow the road down to the main farm area and explore their growing fields and greenhouses.
